- Most of the students that study in the United States are




Studying Abroad

- In the United States, most universities offer a study abroad program which allows their students to travel to another country and will let the student study overseas for a semester.
- The average cost for someone to study abroad is \$18,000 per semester.
- Since these programs are ran through American schools, these students can receive financial aid from the United States and scholarships making it financially easier for students to do this.

The problems created by studying in the United States

- Studying abroad is very expensive.
- The average cost of attendance for international students is almost \$180,000 for four years of education.
- Because these students are from other countries, they cannot apply for federal and state financial aid to help pay for their college tuition.
- Because of the high cost, not a lot of student can travel to America for an education, therefore most students study in their own or in other countries



Benefits of Studying out of your own country

- Students will have the ability to learn multiple cultures and gain an understanding as to how other countries function.
